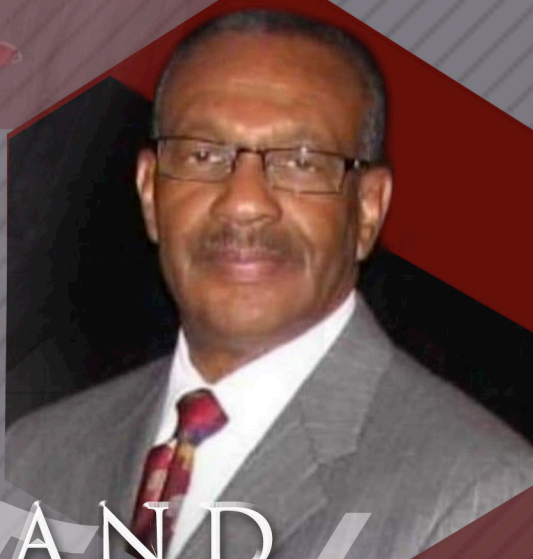

OBITUARY

KUESLAND DELROY TAYLOR was born on November 10, 1952 to his late parents John and Mary Taylor at Clarks Town, Trelawny in Jamaica and is the ninth of ten children. Kuesland graduated from York Castle High School and pursued his higher education at West Indies School of Public Health. He traveled all over the island working as a Health Inspector.

Kuesland and Salomie were joined in holy matrimony on December 22, 1979 on our beautiful island of Jamaica and were blessed with two wonderful children, Oreen Samantha Taylor and Kuesland Philip Taylor.

Kuesland was born into a Christian home and anything other than following the Lord was not an option back then. He LOVED THE LORD and LOVED PEOPLE. He got so excited and enthusiastic when telling people about a Saviour that loves them. He was a Youth Leader, Mentor and Evangelist in Jamaica and was a member of the New Testament Church of God. Kuesland was like a magnet that people gravitated to because of his unconditional love and a passion to win souls for the kingdom of God.

A WORD FROM MININTER KUESLAND:

“Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe in me also. My Father’s house has many rooms; if they were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am” John 14:1-3

In 1981 Kuesland migrated to the United States of America and became interested in Respiratory Therapy. He worked at various hospitals across Baltimore as a Respiratory Therapist for over thirty years. His mission remained the same as in Jamaica; to tell others about the way to Salvation and the path to eternal life, that place where he is living right now. One of his Mottos: If I can help somebody as I pass along then my living shall not be in vain.

It’s one thing to say you love people but Kuesland knew how to show that love. He would give the shirt off his back, stop at every traffic light at each intersection to say a kind word to the person there and give the last dollar in his wallet. He prayed for people in the hospital rooms, the hallways, at Ithop and wherever necessary. In the midnight hour and early morning Kuesland could be heard interceding for his family and others.

His infectious smile was catching and his common question to each person was, how are you doing today? And he waited for an answer. Kuesland touched lives across countries, states and culture. He was born into the second of eight generations and God gave him the gift to relate across all generations from the eldest down to the youngest because he knew how to listen.

Kuesland has been a part of the Long Reach/Celebration Church ministry for over 38 years and he has been godly proud of the leadership and his church family. He has served as part of the G-12 group, cell leader, men’s ministry and preaching ministry. A place where “Jesus brought him all the way” and a place where he believed in “Helping people win in life. He loved worshiping and praising the Lord

There will be a void on earth with the transitioning of Kuesland to his eternal life, but his great legacy will live on. He will be remembered by his loving wife Salomie Goodall-Taylor, of forty years; his daughter Oreen Taylor, son K. Philip Taylor. His eight brothers and sisters and his many nieces and nephew, grand and great grand nieces and nephews.

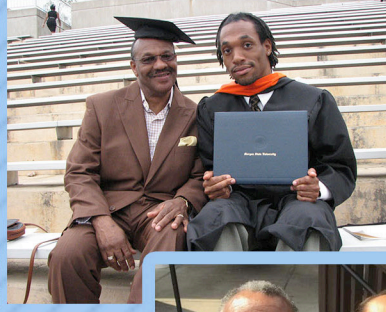
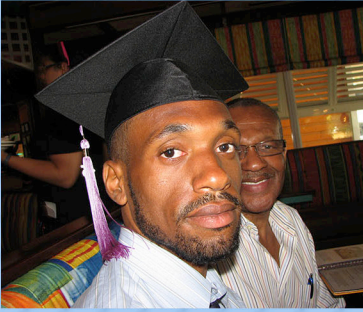
